Touch Football Australia and NSW Touch will now take a payment of \$30 and \$30 when you register into your first Touch competition anywhere in Australia between July 1st to June 30 of each year. The \$30 covers Insurance and the \$30 covers Affiliation. This payment will take place

at the same time when a player registers into their first competition after July 1st. These payments go directly to TFA and NSW Touch and are only collected once a year regardless of how many competitions you play in. It is important that you use the same MYSIDELINE account for all your touch competitions otherwise you will pay \$30 and \$30 more than once a year. Please do not create a new account, use the lost account details tab or support email that MYSIDELINES offer.

Registration Process

All team delegates are required to add their team on our competition website.

All players must register themselves after the team organiser has entered the team.

All teams organisers must make a credit card / debit card payment of **\$300 deposit** at the time of registration. Failure to make the payment will result in the team not being accepted into the competition.

Teams may not have more than 14 registered players. Teams who require more than 14 players need to contact the committee for approval.

Important notes regarding payment

- We will only accept payments from team delegates
- Individual team members must not make deposits directly into the club bank account

Active Kids Vouchers

Teams can use Active Kids Vouchers. Team delegates please contact paul.farah@centralcoasttouch.com with the list of players and their Active Kids Voucher details. Please send the compiled list when **all** players have passed their details to the team delegate.

Registration Deadline

All players must be registered by **Monday 27th April 2026**.

This does not negate the requirement for players to register themselves before taking part in matches. This simply marks the last date that players may be added to a playing roster, allowing them to participate in future matches.

Cash Payments

The remainder of fees after paying the online deposit must be paid by electronic funds transfer, we will not accept cash payments.

Balance of Fees

All outstanding fees \$695 for Senior Teams and \$625 for Junior Teams must be paid into the bank account and cleared no later than **Monday 27th April 2026**.

Teams that have not paid in full by this date will not be entered into the competition draw for the season and the deposit will be forfeit.

If vacancies exist, late entries and payments may be accepted.

Juniors in Senior Competition

All juniors in our senior competition must turn 14 by the end of the season; this means, date of birth on or before the **15 July 2012**. Parents of children born after this date may write to the committee to seek an exemption. Each case will be considered individually by the Junior Committee.

Players in Multiple Teams

The association will do its best to ensure that players playing in Mixed and Womens/Mens do not clash. Players and team organisers must ensure that players registering in two teams understand their teams may play at the same time.

Players can only play in one mixed team, one men's team and one women's team.

Finals Qualifications

Players must have played two regular season games and be registered online in a particular team in a particular division to qualify for finals.

Forfeits

Team organisers should text or phone Paul Farah on 0410305771. This must take place before 5pm.

If the team organiser is away they should give the responsibility to somebody else in the team. Any registered member of the team is able to forfeit on behalf of the team.

Once you have forfeited you cannot cancel it. In the event of wet weather, forfeits will automatically be undone.

If a team forfeits two or more games during the one season the committee reserves the right to withdraw that team from the competition or the team from the finals series without refund.

Referees

We are always welcoming new referees. If any member of your team wishes to become a referee please ask them to contact Paul Farah 0410 305 771.

The association will provide coaching, on-field uniform, and may cover the cost of badge courses for referees who officiate on a regular basis.

Playing Uniform

- All players in a team must have numbered playing shirts that are of the same colour.
- Teams who do not comply with this will not be able to participate in the semi finals.
- Teams are not to play in *pink* shirts as that is the referees colour.
- Players may be asked to leave the field at any time during the season if they are not in uniform.

The association has purchased shirts for our referees - these are a fluorescent pink colour. Teams must not choose pink as your predominant colour to avoid any conflict with the referees. If you have any doubts, please contact us with your shirt design for approval.

If you would like the club to organise your team shirts the cost will be \$350 for 14 plain cotton shirts. Email paul.farah@centralcoastouch.com with sizes and colour.

Wet Weather Policy

Game Times

630pm, 715pm, 800pm. Games will be 35 minutes straight with no half time. Touch down, turn around. Each time a team scores, teams change ends. Start times and game lengths are subject to the amount of teams entered and playing double headers to catch up wet weather games.

Special requests for preferred times will be handled as best we can. Due to large numbers of players involved in Mens/Womens and Mixed, this can be difficult to accommodate every week.

Players in multiple teams should not expect to be scheduled to play in consecutive time slots.
